AUGUST MEETING BY CHIP

August was all about tool sharpening. It is important to keep your scissors and cutters as sharp as possible so the cuts are clean and even. We do not want to tear the branch or stems as that could provide an opportunity for disease to take hold. Plus, it will not look as tidy as it should.

Several people have asked where I got the sharpening stones I was using during the demonstration, and I do not remember, but here is a link to a set I found online, that is reasonably priced.

SEPTEMBER MEETING BY CHIP

At our September meeting, we will talk about pests and weeds – and moss. We are heading into the next period where we can consider re-potting, and wiring. I would hold off on minor pruning, as there is likely not enough time for new buds to form before fall, but if you have been eyeing a branch that needs to be removed, this can be considered. Note: be careful of flowering trees that have set next year's buds, so do not disturb them (knock them off).

Loss is part of growth. Whether it is a branch that we hoped to develop further, or sadly the entire tree. It is still part of our learning and journey of our bonsai development. Take these "setbacks" as a learning experience, and as disheartening or frustrating as it may be, take some time to understand what was done (or not done) that caused this unfortunate situation. Did we cut the branch back too hard, or bend it a bit too much? Or did we re-pot during the wrong time? Did we over-prune the roots? Or not get the soil fully worked into the roots? Not enough water or fertilizer? Or perhaps the tree had a pest or disease? All these questions must be asked of ourselves, and we need to reflect what we can do differently or pay attention to for the rest of our trees. Loss is always sad, but through this regrettable event, perhaps we will acquire a better understanding of our little trees and what they need to survice.
